But we see he now feels less threatened by it now. He now understands better that it is a process, it is a matter of persistence and practice, and that one step at a time he can pretty much learn anything. (And the iPad is such an appealing platform that doing the math worksheets does not seem tedious to him). That is a major breakthrough for us.	Very much so - I see that he will be able to learn any math concept and that he is even likely to come to like math.	We could not be happier with this product. The educational team has really tailored the worksheets to our needs. There is regular, easy communication with Tabor's instructors, and the iPad app is appealing and easy to use. But if I had to summarize what I most like about Tabor is that the child can do it completely on his/her own and that is EXTREMELY useful for busy parents!!!). But at the same time, as parents, we retain control and oversight of the situation by having weekly reports from the tutor, quick access to feedback on worksheets, and the possibility of conversations with the tutor regularly.
